



2019 LAURA DOZER AWARD HONOREE



There is no more fitting award for Dr. Michael Kruer than the UCP Laura Dozer Award. A caring, dedicated, respected pediatric neurologist and expert in cerebral palsy, movement disorders and rare diseases, Dr. Kruer is passionate about helping children with disabilities and their families. The award cherishes the memory of Laura Grace Dozer. Born three months premature and facing many challenges during her short nine years on earth, Laura left an incredible mark on everyone blessed to know her.

Dr. Kruer became passionate about movement disorders and rare diseases while trying to help families find answers and hope. Those experiences led Dr. Kruer to combine his work with young patients with a translational laboratory research program. Dr. Kruer is currently the director of the Cerebral Palsy & Pediatric Movement Disorders Program at Barrow Neurological Institute at Phoenix Children's Hospital, and an associate professor at the University of Arizona's College of Medicine Phoenix in the Department of Child Health.

He is the chair of the International Cerebral Palsy Genomics Consortium, a worldwide collaborative, seeking to understand genetic contributions to CP in order to help develop better diagnostics and treatments. Dr. Kruer's research has been supported by the National Institutes of Health, the Dystonia Medical Research Foundation, and the American Academy of Cerebral Palsy and Developmental Medicine among others. His awards include, selection as an American Academy of Neurology Clinical Research Fellow, a Clinical Scientist Development Award from the Doris Duke Charitable Foundation, and the Shields Award from the Child Neurology Society. Dr. Kruer believes that the most impactful translational research occurs when families, physicians and researchers partner to drive innovation and better serve those in need.

The Laura Dozer Award commends a corporation or individual who goes above and beyond their normal daily responsibilities to support, nurture and promote a life without limits for those served by UCP. In nominating Dr. Kruer for the 2019 award, past UCP Board Chair Heather Heller and CEO Brenda Hanserd said, "Dr. Kruer's dedication to the care and healing of children with cerebral palsy is enormous and his international research collaborations are improving the quality of life for an untold number of children. In providing hope to families with children with CP and other disabilities, Dr. Kruer epitomizes that life should be without limits."
